



## **CONDITIONS OF PLAY FOR JUBILEE SALVER**

1. Event to be played on the Saturday – Single Stroke/ Qualifying round.
2. Players must signify their intention to compete by placing 'Q' on the card the player **must insure** they are available to play **All Dates** of the Competition
3. Best 8 - nett on countback to qualify. There must be 8 qualifying for the competition to proceed.
4. Play to be from Red plates.
5. Prizes            Winner & Runner Up
6. Player must be present 15minutes prior to hit-off. If a player is not present to hit-off at due time, the match will be forfeited. A forfeit once given, cannot under any circumstances, be redeemed.
7. Match play conditions and rules apply.
8. Match Play – Full Difference in handicap, no limit to difference in handicap  
All matches to be played off current GA handicap at time of Qualifying round.  
Strokes given are as the match play index at the bottom of the score card.
9. If match is squared at the 18<sup>th</sup> it then becomes sudden death play-off.  
Off the 1<sup>st</sup> hole with handicaps re commencing.
10. Mobile Phones 9.1 The use of a mobile or portable phone by a competitor or his caddie, whilst on the golf course during an event is distracting and inconsiderate. If the competitor or caddie is in the possession of a mobile or portable phone it should be turned off. If the phone rings this is deemed to be in use and the Committee may take disciplinary action against the offending player in accordance with the concluding paragraph of section 1, Etiquette of the Rules of Golf. If the phone has a distance measuring device facility it may be used in line with Condition 8. However, the 'phone communication' facility should be turned off. In match play, the opponent should be informed if the player plans to use this facility
11. Use of motorised transport is permitted.
