



CONDITIONS OF PLAY FOR SINGLE KNOCKOUT

1. 3 Divisions:
Div 1 GA 0 - 21.0 Div 2 GA 21.1 – 29.1 Div 3 GA 29.2 - 45.4
2. Players must signify their intention by placing 'Q' the card. The player **must insure** they are available to play all dates of the Competition
3. Best 8 Stableford score in each division – nett on countback to qualify.
There must be 8 qualify in a division for the competition to proceed.
4. Prizes Winner & Runner Up in ea Division
5. In the event of a tie, positioning for qualifiers to be decided on a countback rules apply.
6. Players must be present 15 minutes prior to hit-off. If a player is not present to hit-off at due time, the match will be forfeited
7. A forfeit once given, cannot under any circumstances, be redeemed.
8. Play to be from Red plates
9. Match play conditions and rules apply.
10. Match Play – Full Difference in handicap, no limit to difference in handicap.
All matches to be played off current WGA handicap at time of Qualifying round.
11. If match is squared at the 18th it then becomes sudden death play-off.
Off the 1st hole with handicaps re commencing. For each round
12. Mobile Phones 9.1 The use of a mobile or portable phone by a competitor or his caddie, whilst on the golf course during an event is distracting and inconsiderate. If the competitor or caddie is in the possession of a mobile or portable phone it should be turned off. If the phone rings this is deemed to be in use and the Committee may take disciplinary action against the offending player in accordance with the concluding paragraph of section 1, Etiquette of the Rules of Golf. If the phone has a distance measuring device facility it may be used in line with Condition 8. However, the 'phone communication' facility should be turned off. In match play, the opponent should be informed if the player plans to use this facility
13. Use of motorised transport is permitted.
