



CONDITIONS OF PLAY FOR **CHRISTMAS OPEN**

BEST 3 SCORE OF 4 (TEAM STABLEFORD)

1. Open to all Clubs affiliated with WGA
2. The WGA Members' Ladies Committee of Beverley Park Golf Club will be the absolute Umpire of any dispute or protest and its decision will be final. Rules of golf and local rules of Beverley Park Golf Club will be the rules of the day. The Match Committee shall have full power or make variations in the conditions of play, the draw or the program should they deem it necessary. In the event of a tie normal countback rules apply.
3. In the event of ties, winner shall be decided by a countback over the last 9 – 6 – 3 then hole by hole.
4. Competitors are requested to be ready to play 15 minutes ahead of their starting time.
5. Trophies Winners – Best 3 scores of 4 Stableford Nett
Scratch over the field
1st, 2nd, 3rd & 4th Runners up [should size of field allow it]
NTP, Park Pin, Longest Drive, 2nd shot on 18th hole.
6. No team can win more than one major trophy.
7. Mobile Phones 9.1 The use of a mobile or portable phone by a competitor or his caddie, whilst on the golf course during an event is distracting and inconsiderate. If the competitor or caddie is in the possession of a mobile or portable phone it should be turned off. If the phone rings this is deemed to be in use and the Committee may take disciplinary action against the offending player in accordance with the concluding paragraph of section 1, Etiquette of the Rules of Golf. If the phone has a distance measuring device facility it may be used in line with Condition 8. However, the 'phone communication' facility should be turned off. In match play, the opponent should be informed if the player plans to use this facility.
8. Use of motorised transport is permitted.
